

## **Nomination Form & Rules for All-Novice Show Hi-Point Youth and Amateur Awards**

Tennessee Quarter Horse Association, the official state affiliate of AQHA, will be giving overall High Point and Reserve awards to the novice youth and novice amateur who accumulate the most points at the TQHA novice shows as defined below. During the show year, there will be several all novice shows that will count for points. Please refer to the TQHA website for dates and locations of those shows and the awards that will be given. (www.tqha.org.)

### **RULES**

1. This nomination form must be completed at the first All-Novice show for which your points will count. There is no charge for competing; however your points will not count unless this form is turned in.
2. Exhibitors participating in the Hi-Point competition must be a member of the Tennessee Quarter Horse Association and the corresponding Tennessee Youth or Amateur Association. All awards are calculated on a one horse/one exhibitor combination.
3. The cumulative point totals from all TQHA All-Novice shows will be used to determine the winners of the awards. Horses that place receive one point for each horse beaten up to a maximum of 45 horses plus one point for entering the class.
4. The exhibitor with the most points in each respective division (youth or amateur) will be declared the high-point winner and the next highest point total will be the reserve high point.
5. In the event of point ties: The horse accumulating the greatest number of first place wins will prevail. If first place wins do not break the tie, second place wins, and then third place wins, etc., until the tie is broken.
